Monday 20th - School re-opens for Summer Term 1, gates open at 8.30am.

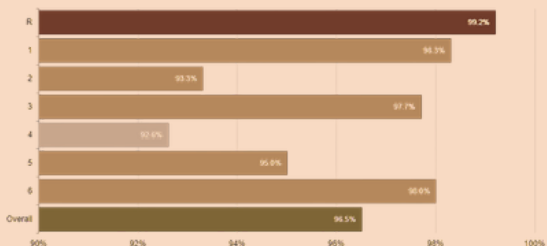
Tuesday 21st - Y6 "Coping with SATs" workshop (during the school day) followed by parent /carer workshop at 3.30pm, ran by MHST.
