Please ensure that all accounts are brought up to date before the summer holidays. This includes school lunches on Cre8te.

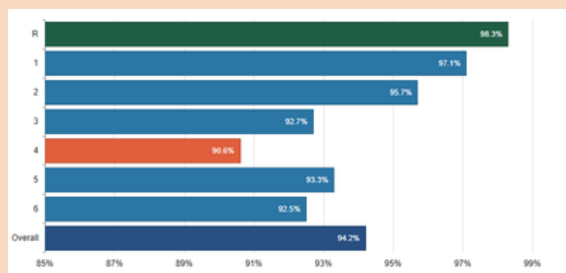
